Research Analysis

SB 410 creates the Alyssa D. Wiles Law. The measure amends the Youthful Offender Act to lower the age limit on certain crimes, so those who commit the acts must be tried as youthful offenders beginning at age 13. Additionally, a young person charged with accessory to these crimes must also be charged as a youthful offender.
