**Research Analysis**

The measure creates the Representative W.D. “Bill Bradley Memorial Highway” and directs the Department of Transportation to place suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure directs the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to place permanent markers upon the highway bearing the name of the individual to be honored. 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the armed forces who were killed in action. The individual named in this measure is not an armed forces member killed in action, therefore the cost of the signage will be paid by the sponsoring group.
