Research Analysis

Engrossed SB423 repeals several provisions relating to the advertisement and sale of secondhand watches. The measure strikes from law the requirement that secondhand watches include a tag labeled secondhand and that advertisements to sell secondhand watches include a disclosure about the secondhand nature of the watch. The measure also strikes from law the penalty for selling a secondhand watch without proper disclosure.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 423 repeals all laws regarding the sale of secondhand watches, including the punishment of a misdemeanor for violations of those rules, as well as repealing a fine. The fiscal impact to the state depends on the amount of convictions for crimes related to the sales of second hand watches. The impact is most likely minimal to nothing.
