Research Analysis

SB 534 deletes obsolete language regarding the Child Abuse Training and Coordination Program within the Oklahoma State Department of Health; establishes a Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Team Account Fund within the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth (OCCY) for purposes of contracting with multidisciplinary child abuse teams; modifies how funds in the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Account (CAMA) at DHS are allocated by deleting references to multidisciplinary teams; requires OCCY to submit a report to the Legislature outlining performance measures for multidisciplinary teams and recommending changes to the CAMA funding formula.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 534 calls for the creation of the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary Team Account (CAMTA) fund, which will be funded as an appropriation and will be administered by OCCY. The funds will come from the \$2.8 million already appropriated each year for the CAMA fund, which is administered by OKDHS. Roughly \$800,000-\$1,000,000 will go to the CAMTA fund, the remainder to the CAMA fund.
