Research Analysis

SB 592 removes the maximum amount of fine that can be assessed against a person installing a mobile or manufactured home in violation of Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Dealers statutes. The measure provides that licenses to engage in the business as a used motor vehicle dealer, used motor vehicle salesperson, wholesale used motor vehicle dealer, manufactured home dealer, restricted manufactured home park dealer, manufactured home salesperson, manufactured home installer, or manufactured home manufacturer selling directly to a licensed manufactured home dealer that are issued prior January 1, 2016 and ending in an even number shall expire on December 31, 2016. An application for renewal is to be for 2 years. Any license issued before January 1, 2016, and ending in an uneven or odd number shall expire December 31, 2017. All applicants for renewal of such license before January 1, 2016, shall pay the appropriate two year license fee. License fees are increased in accordance with changing from a one-year to a two-year license. The measure also removes reference to buyer's identification cards.
