**Research Analysis**

SB 658 places primary authority for asbestos abatement with the Labor Commissioner. The measure adds to the duties of the Labor Commissioner, to protect health from hazards posed by friable asbestos.

The bill repeals Title 40, Section 457, which puts the Commissioner of Health in charge of asbestos abatement.
