**Fiscal Analysis**

According to officials with the Department of Public Safety, “it (SB683) will cost the agency well over a million dollars and we feel will move our driver license program backwards instead of forwards. It does away with some of our security features and is not something we as an agency can support.”

The PCS to SB683 also repeals law which would now allow the Department to move forward with implementing REAL ID. The costs associated with said implementation are currently unknown, as legislation pertaining to that issue is currently undergoing deliberations.
