**Research Analysis**

Engrossed SB71 modifies the definition of *basic industry*, as it relates the Oklahoma Quality Jobs Program Act, to include agricultural activities classified in the NAICS Manual under U.S Industry No 112310. Industry No. 112310 applies to establishments primarily engaged in chicken egg production.

**Fiscal Analysis**

SB 71 proposes to amend the Oklahoma Quality Jobs Program Act (68 O.S. § 3603) by adding establishments that are classified in the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) Manual under Industry Number 112310 - Chicken Egg Production<sup>1</sup> as eligible for the incentive.

No reduction in revenue is anticipated as a result of this proposal due to the revenue neutral features of the Oklahoma Quality Jobs Program Act.

<sup>1</sup> This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in raising chickens for egg production. The eggs produced may be for use as table eggs or hatching eggs.
