PROPOSAL: Amendatory

Section 1 proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 1135.5 by creating a special license plate for any person wishing to provide financial support for A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE). It allows the special license plate to be issued for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, in the same manner as personalized plates. It further provides that as space permits the motorcycle special plate may be of similar design to the one for vehicles or a new design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The bill provides that a fee amount may be used for entering into any required licensing agreement for use of the association's logo or design. It further states that the licensing agreement shall provide for a \$20 payment to the ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation.

Section 2 proposes to create a State Treasury revolving fund for the ABATE of Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund.

ATTACHMENT TO FISCAL IMPACT-SB 1062-[Introduced]-Prepared January 27, 2016.

Section 1 proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 1135.5 by creating a special license plate for any person wishing to provide financial support for A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE). It allows the special license plate to be issued for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, in the same manner as personalized plates. It further provides that as space permits the motorcycle special plate may be of similar design to the one for vehicles or a new design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The bill provides that a fee amount may be used for entering into any required licensing agreement for use of the association's logo or design. It further states that the licensing agreement shall provide for a \$20 payment to the ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation.

The annual fee for special license plates issued pursuant to the amended section is \$35 and is in addition to all other annual vehicle registration fees. Of this amount, \$20 (or any other statutorily provided amount) shall be apportioned or provided in a fund specified within the authorizing paragraph. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) shall be deposited in the OTC Reimbursement Fund to be used for administrative purposes associated with issuance of the special license plate and any remaining amounts of the \$35 fee are to be apportioned as motor vehicle collections pursuant to the provisions of 47 O.S. § 1104.

The proposed -- if necessary -- \$20 licensing agreement payment amount to ABATE of Oklahoma Foundation for possible use of the association's logo or design on each such special license plate issued would result in a corresponding \$8 deposit to the OTC Reimbursement Fund and a \$7 deposit for apportionment as motor vehicle collections. Any estimated revenue impact will be minimal (positive in nature).

Section 2 proposes to create a State Treasury revolving fund for the ABATE of Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund.

The estimated revenue impact is minimal/positive. There is no estimated administrative impact associated with the proposed amendment.
