Re: Proposed Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1538
RBH No. 9256

Under Proposed Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1538 OLERS members who have retired or with a service connected disability would have their benefit equal to the greater of (a) and (b) where

- (a) Is 2.5% times the number of years of credit service times the top base pay currently paid to an active member for the following positions:
 - 1. Oklahoma Highway Patrolman
 - 2. Communications Dispatcher
 - 3. Capitol Patrolman
 - 4. Lake Patrolman
 - 5. OSBI Special Agent or Criminalist
- (b) Is 2.5% times credited service times the member's final average salary.

This bill would treat those that have or will retire due to a service connected disability the same as other service retirements and would be effective January 1, 2015.

Proposed Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1538 is a non fiscal retirement bill. The Systems actuaries determined the increase in accrued liability is \$3,694,000. The bill calls for an appropriation from the Special Cash Fund of \$3,694,000 fully fund the increase in liability as called for under OPLAAA.
