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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:									
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.2, as									
18	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 178, O.S.L. 2018 (59 O.S. Supp.									
19	2020, Section 1151.2), is amended to read as follows:									
20	Section 1151.2 As used in the Roofing Contractor Registration									
21	Act:									
22	1. "Advertise" means any written publication, dissemination,									
23	solicitation, contract, bid, promotional item, or circulation which									
24	is intended to directly or indirectly induce any person to contract									

1 for roofing construction services with the advertiser, including, 2 but not limited to, business cards, telephone directory display 3 advertisements, vehicle signage, radio, television and electronic 4 solicitations;

2. "Applicant" means the qualifying party, or if no qualifying
party, any person applying under the Roofing Contractor Registration
Act for a roofing contractor registration to be issued by the
Construction Industries Board;

9 3. "Board" means the Construction Industries Board;
10 4. "Committee" means the Committee of Roofing Examiners;
11 5. "Homeowner" means one who owns and resides in, or who
12 resides in, or who contracts for the purchase, construction,
13 remodeling or repairing of a residence;

14 6. "Nonresident contractor" means any contractor who has not
15 established and maintained a place of business as a roofing
16 contractor in this state within the preceding year, or who claims
17 residency in another state, or who has not submitted an income tax
18 return as a resident of this state within the preceding year;

19 7. "Owner" means person who owns the property or is a lessee of 20 the property;

8. "Person" means any natural person, firm, limited or general
partnership, corporation, association, limited liability company,
trust, association, other legal entity and any organization capable
of conducting business, or any combination thereof acting as a unit,

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unless the intent to give a more limited meaning is disclosed
 clearly by the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

9. "Prime contractor" means a general contractor, commercial
contractor, or other contractor who contracts directly with the
owner for construction trade work in multiple trade areas;

6 10. "Project manager" means one who manages construction7 projects consisting of work involving multiple trades;

"Public contract" means a contract with the State of 8 11. 9 Oklahoma, its political subdivisions, or any board, commission, or 10 department thereof, or with any board of county commissioners, or 11 with any city council, school board, or with any state or municipal agency, or with any other public board, body, commission, or agency 12 13 authorized to award contracts for the construction or reconstruction 14 of public works and includes subcontracts undertaken to perform 15 works covered by the original contract or any part thereof;

16 12. "Qualifying party" means a natural person who is an officer 17 or owner of the corporation, a member of the limited liability 18 company, or a general partner of the limited liability partnership, 19 and who is actively engaged in the work undertaken by the registrant 20 for which a registration is required pursuant to the Roofing 21 Contractor Registration Act who meets the experience and ability 22 requirements for registration on behalf of the registrant;

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13. "Registrar" means the Construction Industries Board or any
 person designated by the Board to administer the provisions of the
 Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

4 14. "Registration" means the process of applying for an initial
5 or renewal registration which upon approval is exhibited by a
6 registration number and card issued pursuant to the Roofing
7 Contractor Registration Act;

8 15. "Registration number" means the roofing registration number 9 issued by the registrar to the registrant's qualifying party; 10 16. "Registrant" means a holder of a registration issued

11 pursuant to the Roofing Contractor Registration Act;

"Residence" means a single structure for residential 12 17. 13 occupancy or use which is a detached one- to four-family dwelling or 14 a multiple single-family dwelling (townhouse) not more than three 15 stories/floors above grade plane in height with a separate means of 16 egress, and any appurtenances thereto, which is intended for use as 17 a primary habitation and is in compliance with the International 18 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code 19 Commission;

20 18. "Roofing contractor" means any person, including a 21 subcontractor and nonresident contractor, engaged in the business of 22 commercial or residential roofing contractor work, or who himself or 23 herself, or through another, attempts to or advertises, holds 24 himself or herself out as having, or purports to have, the capacity

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to undertake roofing contractor work, or offers to engage in or solicits roofing installation-related services, including construction, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, repair, maintenance, alteration, and waterproofing, unless specifically exempted in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. Roofing contractor shall not mean:

- a. a person engaged in the demolition of a structure or
 the cleanup of construction waste and debris that
 contains roofing material,
- b. a person working under the direct supervision of the
 roofing contractor who is hired either as an employee,
 day laborer, or contract laborer whose payment,
 received in any form, from the roofing contractor is
 subject to self-employment tax,
- c. a person working on his or her own property or that of
 an immediate relative and such person is not receiving
 any compensation, or
- 18d. a person acting as a handyman who is receiving19compensation from the property owner and who is20performing the roofing repair in conjunction with21other repairs to the property and who does not perform22more than two roofing jobs per year;

19. "Roofing contractor work" means the installation,
 fabrication or assembly of equipment or systems included in roofing

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1 systems as defined in the International Building Code and the International Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 2 Building Code Commission, and which codes are hereby adopted and 3 incorporated by reference. Roofing construction work includes, but 4 5 is not limited to, installation, renovation, remodeling, reroofing, reconstructing, repair, maintenance, improvement, alteration, and 6 7 waterproofing, unless specifically exempted in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act. 8

"Commercial roofing contractor work" means work done 9 a. on commercial, industrial or public building roofing 10 systems or structures as defined in the International 11 12 Building Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform 13 Building Code Commission; except it does not mean 14 buildings used for commercial purposes having 15 equivalent or substantially the same roofing 16 requirements as a "residence" defined herein, 17 including but not limited to business offices 18 converted from a structure that formerly was a 19 residence, and

b. "Residential roofing contractor work" means work done
on roofing systems as defined in the International
Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform
Building Code Commission, or as defined as a
"residence" herein; including buildings used for

commercial purposes having asphalt shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes, wood shakes or other comparable materials applied to a sloped roof equal to the same roofing requirements as a "residence" defined herein, including but not limited to business offices converted from a structure that formerly was a residence;

8 20. "Roofing Hearing Board" means the Roofing Hearing Board 9 which shall consist of a designee of the Construction Industries 10 Board, as chair, and the members of the Committee of Roofing 11 Examiners;

12 21. "Subcontractor" means one who contracts with a prime 13 contractor, general contractor, residential contractor, project 14 manager, property manager, another subcontractor, or another entity 15 for roofing contractor work;

16 22. "Variance" means the use of an alternative material or 17 method of construction from that prescribed in the International 18 Building Code or the International Residential Code or other 19 approved documents by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission 20 for use at a particular location or project specified in the 21 variance application;

22 23. "Variance and Appeals Board" means the Oklahoma State23 Roofing Installation Code Variance and Appeals Board;

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24. "Labor-only crews crew" means a crew that is to perform the
 installation of asphalt shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes,
 wood shakes or other comparable materials to a sloped roof and to
 complete roofing work; and

5 25. <u>"Labor-only subcontractor" means a registered roofing</u> 6 <u>subcontractor that is hired and directly supervised by a commercial-</u> 7 <u>endorsed roofing contractor to perform the labor for installation of</u> 8 <u>roofing work and does not provide any roofing materials for the</u> 9 work; and

10 <u>26.</u> "Prefabricated- or pre-engineered-metal-building erector" 11 means the labor necessary to construct the components of a 12 prefabricated- or pre-engineered-metal-building package, known as 13 PEMB, as defined by the Construction Science Institute and 14 Construction Specifications Institute in Division 13, Special 15 Construction: Metal Building Systems.

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 SECTION 2.
 AMENDATORY
 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1151.9, as

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 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 178, O.S.L. 2018 (59 O.S. Supp.

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 2020, Section 1151.9), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1151.9 A. Any administrative or governing body with authority to enter into public contracts shall require individual roofing contractor registration for purposes of such persons submitting or entering into any bid or contract involving roofing contractor work.

24 B. The Roofing Contractor Registration Act does not apply to:

An actual owner of residential or farm property who
 physically performs, or has family member, employee or employees who
 perform, with or without remuneration, roofing services including,
 construction, installation, renovation, repair, maintenance,
 alteration, waterproofing, or removal of materials or structures on
 property owned by such person;

Any authorized employee, representative or representatives
of the United States Government, the State of Oklahoma, or any
county, municipality, or other political subdivision of this state;
3. Any person who furnishes any fabricated or finished product,
material, or article of merchandise which is not incorporated into
or attached to real property by such person so as to become affixed
thereto;

4. Any person including churches or other charitable entities that provide roof repairs or replacements at no charge using volunteer labor;

5. Any employee of a registrant who does not hold himself or herself out for hire, advertise, or engage in contracting, except as an employee of a registrant;

6. Licensed engineers, licensed architects, licensed HVAC and any other person licensed by the jurisdiction, operating under the purview and within the scope of their respective license;

23 7. A person who only furnishes roofing materials, roofing
24 supplies or equipment and does not, nor do the person's employees,

1 install or fabricate them into or consume them in the performance of 2 the work of the roofing contractor;

8. Prime contractors, general contractors, property managers and project managers who bid on construction trade work in areas additional to roofing contractor work, and subcontract the roofing contractor work as long as they subcontract the roofing work to a currently registered roofing contractor who is in good standing; if the bid is solely for roofing contractor work, then a registration is required;

10 9. Owners of commercial properties including residential rental properties consisting of four dwelling units or less, when acting as 11 their own roofing contractor and providing all material supervision 12 13 themselves, lessees of residential properties with the consent of 14 the owner, who, whether themselves or with their own employees, 15 perform roofing construction in or upon the properties, all 16 installing roofing materials according to the International Building 17 Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, 18 or the manufacturer's installation instructions;

19 10. Owners of property when acting as their own roofing 20 contractor, providing all material supervision themselves, and 21 installing roofing materials according to the International 22 Residential Code, as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code 23 Commission, or the manufacturer's installation instructions when 24 building or improving a single-family dwelling residence on such

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1 property for the occupancy of such owners and not intended for sale 2 In any action brought under the Roofing Contractor or rent. Registration Act, proof of the sale or offering for sale of such 3 structure or the renting or offering to rent of such structure by 4 5 the owners of the property within one (1) year after substantial completion of the structure when the structure can be occupied and 6 7 used as intended but punch list items may remain, is presumptive 8 evidence that the construction was undertaken with the intent of 9 sale or rent; or

10 11. Metal building erectors who install prefabricated- or preengineered-metal-building packages, known as PEMBs, as defined by the Construction Science Institute and Construction Specifications Institute in Division 13, Special Construction: Metal Building Systems.

15 C. <u>1.</u> Labor-only crews performing the installation of asphalt 16 shingles, tile shingles, synthetic shakes or wood shakes to a sloped 17 roof must be registered but are not required to have a commercial 18 endorsement.

19 <u>2. Labor-only subcontractors performing the labor for</u> 20 <u>installation of roofing work must be registered but are not required</u> 21 <u>to have a commercial endorsement and must be under direct on-site</u> 22 <u>supervision of a full-time employee of the commercial-endorsed</u> 23 <u>contractor.</u>
