REVISED TO REMOVE SB2044

1. **SB1503 By Daniels of the Senate**
Choosing Childbirth Act; allowing out-of-state organizations to receive grants. Effective date.
2. **SB1642 By Frix of the Senate and Marti of the House**
Controlled dangerous substances; authorizing divided quantities for certain acute pain opioid prescriptions. Effective date.
3. **SB1553 By Kern of the Senate**
Medicaid; specifying certain qualifications for appeals; providing for recovery of certain costs. Effective date.
4. **SB1427 By Hicks of the Senate**
Public health; mandating certain pediatric screenings for type 1 diabetes; providing for certain reimbursement and funding. Effective date.
5. **SB1421 By Dossett of the Senate**
Mental health; requiring nonphysical intervention training for certain facilities and programs. Effective date.
6. **SB1837 By Reinhardt of the Senate**
Medicaid home- and community-based services; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek certain exemption. Effective date.
7. **SB1566 By Stanley of the Senate and Stinson of the House (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3609)**

Medicaid; modifying requirements and procedures related to applied behavior analysis treatment for autism spectrum disorder. Effective date.

8. **SB1567 By Stanley of the Senate**

Practice of nursing; modifying restriction on supervision fees for Advanced Practice Registered Nurses; prohibiting certain requirements by the Oklahoma Board of Nursing. Effective date.

9. **SB1794 By Stanley of the Senate (Proposed Comm. Sub., req. #3612)**

Mental health; requiring establishment of certain behavioral health vacancy registry; requiring certain registration and reporting. Effective date.

10. **SB1484 By Rosino of the Senate and Roe of the House**

Medicolegal investigations; broadening certain investigative requirements; requiring certain notice to parent or legal guardian. Effective date.

11. **SB1557 By Rosino of the Senate**

Applied behavior analysis; transferring licensure powers and duties to the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners; requiring background check. Effective date.

12. **SB1564 By Rosino of the Senate**

Medicaid; requiring adoption of certain billing code for specified claims; requiring certain reimbursement. Effective date. Emergency.

13. **SB1591 By Rosino of the Senate**

Medical marijuana; limiting certain THC amounts in certain products and packages. Effective date.
