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10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Insurance Department; stating  
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
13 and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of  
employees; providing budgetary limitations; making  
certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse  
dates; requiring certain budget procedures;  
prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an  
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
20 Insurance Department shall budget all funds in the following  
21 categories and amounts:

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 5 upon the Insurance Department by law shall be set by the Insurance  
 6 Commissioner. The Insurance Department, for the fiscal year ending  
 7 June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
 8 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
 9 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
 10 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
 11 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

15 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by Section 93 of Enrolled Senate  
 16 Bill No. 216 of the 1st Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature,  
 17 not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may  
 18 be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-  
 19 10) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011  
 20 (hereafter FY-11). Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only  
 21 through June 30, 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010.  
 22 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for  
 23 FY-11, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
 24 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered

1 only through June 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15,  
2 2011, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then  
3 current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in  
4 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not  
5 required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted  
6 for FY-11, after the agency to which the funds have been  
7 appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program  
8 revision removing these funds from the FY-10 budget work program and  
9 after such revision has been approved by the Office of State  
10 Finance. Receipt and expenditure of grant funds awarded the  
11 Oklahoma Insurance Department after July 1, 2009, shall be exempt  
12 from expenditure budgetary limitations, provided that any such funds  
13 used for operations shall be included in the agency's budget work  
14 program.

15 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

16 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
