10 An act relating to state agencies; amending 74 O.S.
11 2001, Section 85.17A, which relates to bidding
12 preferences; giving purchasing preferences to certain
13 goods and services under certain circumstances;
14 setting standards for certain purchases; authorizing
15 the addition of a percent increase to certain bid
16 under certain circumstances; and providing an
17 effective date

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 85.17A, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 85.17A A. State agencies shall not discriminate
22 against bidders from states or nations outside Oklahoma, except as
23 provided by this section. State agencies shall reciprocate the
24 bidding preference given by other states or nations to bidders
domiciled in their jurisdictions for acquisitions pursuant to The
Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act. The State Purchasing Director

1 shall annually prepare and distribute to certified procurement
2 officers a schedule providing which states give bidders in their
3 states a preference and the extent of the preference. This schedule
4 shall be used by state agencies in evaluating bids.

5 B. For purposes of awarding contracts state agencies shall:

6 1. Give preference to goods and services that have been
7 manufactured or produced in this state if the price, fitness,
8 availability and quality are otherwise equal;

9 2. Give preference to goods and services from another state
10 over foreign goods or services if goods or services manufactured or
11 produced in this state are not equal in price, fitness,
12 availability, or quality; and

13 3. Add a percent increase to the bid of a nonresident bidder
14 equal to the percent, if any, of the preference given to the bidder
15 in the state in which the bidder resides.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
