13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Scenic Rivers
15 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
19 the Scenic Rivers Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Scenic
21 Rivers Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories
22 and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Scenic Rivers Commission by law shall be set by the
6 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission. The salary of the
7 Administrator of the Scenic Rivers Commission shall not exceed
8 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Scenic Rivers Commission, for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the
11 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
12 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
13 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
14 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
