13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
15 Career and Technology Education from any monies not otherwise
16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
18 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
19 the duties imposed upon the State Board of Career and Technology
20 Education by law.

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
22 Board of Career and Technology Education shall budget all funds in
23 the following categories and amounts:

7 The State Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures
8 for each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education by
12 law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Director of the
13 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall not
14 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
15 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department
16 of Career and Technology Education for the fiscal year ending June
17 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
18 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
19 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
20 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
21 the Oklahoma Statutes:
