10 An Act relating to cities and towns; requiring  
11 verification that certain contractors have certain  
12 insurance; providing exemption; providing for certain  
fee; providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 43-109.2 of Title 11, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Municipalities shall, before issuance of a residential  
20 building permit, verify proof that the contractor has general  
21 liability insurance in an amount required by other construction  
22 trade contractors licensed by the Construction Industries Board and  
23 verify proof that the contractor has workers compensation insurance.

24 A residential building permit shall be defined for this section as

1 any building permit for a single-family or a duplex residential  
2 structure and shall include construction of a new structure, remodel  
3 of an existing structure, and the addition to an existing structure.  
4 Not included under the definition of a residential building permit  
5 are a single-family or a duplex carport, patio cover, storage  
6 building, accessory building, pool, or fence.

7       B. This provision shall not apply to a person or persons  
8 performing the remodeling to his, her, or their own existing single-  
9 family or duplex structure on their own property, unless the  
10 modifications are being subcontracted, in which case the  
11 subcontractor shall meet the requirements set forth in this section.

12       C. If a municipality should require a contractor to register  
13 with the municipality in order to monitor insurance verifications,  
14 the registration fee shall not exceed the fee assessed by the  
15 municipality for other construction trade contractors licensed by  
16 the Construction Industries Board.

17       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
