22	WHEREAS, a federal law mandating participation in a health care	
23	system is a direct violation of states' rights.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: THAT the Oklahoma Legislature petitions the federal government 3 to opt-out of any federal mandates related to health care reform. 4 5 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature petitions the federal government for waivers to the state Medicaid program to enable Oklahoma to 6 7 implement its own health care reform measures. THAT the Oklahoma Legislature petitions the federal government 9 to return any taxes collected from Oklahomans or Oklahoma businesses 10 under federal health care reform to the state in a block grant to enable Oklahoma to implement its own health care reform measures. 11 12 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature opts-out of the federal Medicare 13 program and directs the federal government to return any taxes collected from Oklahomans or Oklahoma businesses for the Medicare 14 15 program to the state.
