**Committee Substitute for
House Bill No. 3238**

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 3238 - By: DERBY of the House.

An Act relating to insurance; defining term; providing that Health Savings Account funds may be used for certain medical procedures; specifying that certain expenditures shall be considered qualified expenses for certain purposes; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 6060.19 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. For the purposes of this section, “medically necessary” shall mean any procedure
5 ordered by a physician, including, but not limited to, bariatric surgery.

6 B. Health Savings Account funds may be used to cover all medically necessary
7 procedures. Use of Health Savings Accounts for medically necessary procedures shall be
8 considered a “qualified medical expense” as provided in Section 6060.15 of Title 36 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes for state tax purposes.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
