| 18 | 2. "Committee" means the Committee of Mechanical Examiners; |
| 19 | 3. "Board" means the Construction Industries Board; |
| 20 | 4. "Gas piping" means and includes all natural gas piping |
| 21 | within or adjacent to any building, structure, or conveyance, on the |
| 22 | premises and to the connection with a natural gas meter, regulator, |
| 23 | or other source of supply; |

- 1 5. "Heating systems" means and includes systems consisting of
- 2 air heating appliances from which the heated air is distributed and
