- 4 SENATE BILL NO. 1330 By: Schulz of the Senate and Armes of the 5 House.
- 6 An Act relating to musk thistle; creating the Musk Thistle 7 Task Force; providing termination date; specifying duties; 8 providing for membership; directing selection of chair and 9 vice-chair; requiring quorum; providing for travel 10 reimbursement; directing staff support by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring 11 certain report; providing for codification; providing an 12 effective date and declaring an emergency. 13
- 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
- 15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
- 16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
- 17 A. There is hereby created until December 31, 2010, the Musk
- 18 Thistle Task Force. The purpose of the task force is to create a
- 19 statewide plan for the eradication of musk thistle.
- 20 B. The task force shall be composed of the members of the
- 21 Senate Agriculture Committee and the members of the House of
- 22 Representatives Agriculture and Rural Development Committee.
- 23 C. The chair of the task force shall be the chair of the Senate
- 24 Agriculture Committee and vice-chair of the task force shall be the
- 25 chair of the House of Representatives Agriculture and Rural
- 26 Development Committee.

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- 1 D. A quorum of the task force shall be required in order for
- 2 the task force to take any final action.
- 3 E. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation for
- 4 their service, but shall be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses
- 5 incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with the
- 6 provisions of Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 7 F. Staff support for the task force shall be provided by the
- 8 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.
- 9 G. The task force shall report its findings, including any
- 10 legislative recommendations to the President Pro Tempore of the
- 11 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
- 12 Governor by December 31, 2010.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.
- 14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
- 16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
- 17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
