8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission; making  
10 an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
11 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
12 requiring certain performance measures; providing for  
13 duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary  
14 of the General Administrator; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Corporation  
18 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
19 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
20 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
21 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
22 upon the Corporation Commission by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
24 Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the General Administrator. The Salary of the General Administrator of the Corporation Commission shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Corporation Commission shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding direct expenditures for well plugging as authorized in Section 310 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pit

1 closure as authorized in Section 140 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma  
2 Statutes, and remediation of sites as authorized in Section 353 of  
3 Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as may be authorized pursuant  
4 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
5 Statutes:
