9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
11 General; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
18 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
19 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
20 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
21 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
2 Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following categories
3 and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the
18 Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal
19 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
20 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as
21 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
22 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
