The Committee Substitute for HB 1032 enacts the “Oklahoma State Government Modernization Act of 2009.” The measure provides that on a monthly basis the Director of Central Purchasing shall provide to the Office of State Finance (OSF) a complete listing in electronic format of all transactions occurring with the aid of a state purchase card. The list shall contain the name of the purchaser and purchasing agency, amount of purchase, and all available descriptions of items purchased. Upon receipt of the list, OSF shall allow the public to access the list in searchable format through the single website defined in O.S. Title 62 Section 46.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Department of Central Services (DCS) advises that the fiscal impact would be minimal, provided the state purchase card information required by the amendment is not considered confidential. If that is the case, then it is possible that extensive modifications could have to be made to the data, such as deleting confidential columns. The cost to provide the report, then, would increase by an amount as yet to be determined.
