**Bill Summary**

The measure is a bill for the purpose of creating the Oklahoma State Government Modernization Act of 2009 and amending gender specific references regarding the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act.

**Fiscal Summary**

HB 1032, as introduced, enacts the “Oklahoma State Government Modernization Act of 2009.” The measure modifies the accepting of giving of gratuities by the State Purchasing Director or any buyer or any officer of the Department of Central Service (DCS), or any member of their immediate family. The measure provides that violation of this Act shall constitute a misdemeanor and that any of the above listed people convicted of a violation shall immediately forfeit their position.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its present form, HB 1032 has no impact on state revenues or resources.
