The measure allows a an expired Oklahoma driver license to be considered a valid form of identification for the purpose of renewing an Oklahoma driver license if the license is not more than 30 days past the date of expiration.

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1092 provides that any Oklahoma driver license that is not more than 30 days past the date of expiration is presumed to be a valid form of identification for the purposes of renewing the driver license.
