The measure adds a computer science end-of-instruction test under the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act.

Fiscal Summary

HB 1511, as introduced, requires the State Board of Education to field test in FY-10 and implement in FY-11 an End-of-Instruction (EOI) test in Computer Science. This EOI test will then be added to a list of five other EOIs from which students will have to choose two on which to demonstrate mastery.

Fiscal Analysis

After consulting with its testing company, the State Department of Education estimates it will cost an additional \$450,000 to develop, field test, and implement this new EOI in Computer Science. Costs the first year will cover development and field testing, costs in future years will cover implementation, scoring, and reporting.
