HB1697 requires courts to provide 10 days notice to the Department of Corrections of any hearing in which the court is requesting the appearance of an inmate under the custody of the Department

HB 1697, as introduced, directs the court clerk to request inmate reports from the Department of Corrections prior to hearings on modification of sentence or revocation of probation.
