Bill Summary

This measure prohibits the chief executive officer or other administrative head of a state agency which has the power to issue a license to a natural person or any person having authority to act on such chief executive officer's or administrative head's behalf from directly or indirectly soliciting support or opposition for legislation from any natural person who holds a license issued by that agency. The measure does not apply to a person who serves on the governing board of the agency or a person who is appointed to serve on a task force or similar entity created by a legislative measure.

The Committee Substitute for HB 2187 prohibits any chief executive officer or other administrative head of a state agency who has the power to issue a license to a natural person or any person having authority to act on such chief executive officer's or administrative head's behalf from directly or indirectly soliciting support or opposition for legislation from any person who holds a license issued by that agency. The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to a person who serves on the governing board of the agency or a person who is appointed to serve on a task force or similar entity created by a legislative measure.
