The committee substitute for HB 2250 increases the fine for persons found guilty of a misdemeanor offense in violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act. The measure authorizes the Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control (OBNDD) to appoint an employee to the unclassified position of Chief Information Officer. The measure also authorizes the Director to purchase vehicles without going through the Department of Central Services, Fleet Management Division.
