FA1 to HB 2250 increases the fine for persons found guilty of a misdemeanor offense in violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act from \$5 to \$200.

Fiscal Analysis

The current \$5 fee is assessed to persons entering a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or is found guilty of the crime of misdemeanor possession of marijuana or drug paraphernalia. The funds are remitted to the Bureau of Narcotics Drug Education Revolving Fund. The fee increase could increase revenue by as much as \$2 million annually.
