Bill Summary

The introduced version of HB2345 creates the Oklahoma Livestock Care Standards Board. The purpose of the Board is to establish standards governing the care and well-being of livestock and poultry in Oklahoma through maintaining food safety, encouraging locally grown and raised food, and protecting Oklahoma farms and families.

The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry shall have the authority to administer and enforce the standards established by the Board. The Legislature may enact laws it deems necessary to carry out the purposes of this bill.
