Bill Summary

The conference committee report for HB2944 restores the title.

HB2944 adds language stating that it is the intent of the Legislature that court appearances should not adversely affect the education of students enrolled in school districts in this state.

To the extent possible, court appearances of public school district employees should be scheduled to minimize the disruption of class time. If a school district employee is subpoenaed to appear as a witness in a civil court proceeding, except in a proceeding in which the school district or the state is a party, the school district shall be entitled to a witness fee equal to the amount of the substitute teacher cost, not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day.
