Bill Summary

This measure, as introduced, authorizes property owners to obtain the services of a licensed wrecker or towing service from an adjacent county to remove an abandoned vehicle, provided that the property owner is unable to obtain the services of a licensed wrecker or towing service within his or her county of residence in a reasonable amount of time. Under current law, a licensed wrecker or towing service located within the county must be used to remove abandoned vehicles from property located in that county. A property owner can enlist the services of a licensed wrecker or towing service to remove a vehicle that the property owner has reasonable cause to believe has been abandoned, provided that the vehicle has been abandoned for a period of forty-eight (48) hours or left on the property without express or implied permission.

HB2959 concerns licensed wreckers and towing service operators and specifies when services may be requested from an adjacent county to remove an abandoned vehicle.
