Bill Summary

Floor Amendment #1 (FA1) to House Bill 3055 specifies that nothing should prohibit a county commissioner from designating a current county employee as a first or chief deputy or assistant, or require the hiring or employment of an individual for such purpose. In addition, the Amendment prohibits individuals from being appointed to serve more than one county commissioner as a first or chief deputy or assistant.

Fiscal Summary

The FA1 to House Bill 3055 specifies that nothing shall prohibit a county commissioner from designating a current county employee as a first or chief deputy or assistant, or require the hiring or employment of an individual for such purpose. However, no individual shall being appointed to serve more than one county commissioner as a first or chief deputy or assistant.
