The Proposed Committee Substitute specifies that Health Savings Account funds may be used to cover any medically necessary procedure, including bariatric surgery.

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3238 provides for the definition of “medically necessary” as it relates to Health Savings Accounts, and provides that such necessary procedures be qualified medical expenses for state tax purposes.
