Bill Summary

The Committee Substitute creates the Aaron Gillming Act. The measure requires persons convicted of a municipal ordinance relating to driving under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance to participate in an alcohol and drug substance abuse evaluation and assessment program. Requires the offender to follow the recommendations of the evaluation and assessment. The Department of Public Safety shall not reinstate the driving privilege of the person until completion of the recommendations.

The committee substitute for HB3240 required persons convicted of violating a municipal ordinance relating to driving under the influence to participate in an alcohol and drug substance abuse evaluation and assessment program prior to sentencing. The cost of the evaluation and assessment will be paid by the offender.
