Bill Summary

The committee substitute to House Bill 3384 strikes the title and creates the Quality of Education Assessment for Oklahoma Citizens Act of 2010. The measure requires every elementary and secondary school to determine if students enrolling were born outside the jurisdiction of the United States and if they qualify for an English as a Second Language remedial program.

When enrolling children, parents shall present birth certificates of children. If administrators determine that a child was born outside the jurisdiction of the United States or if a birth certificate is not available, the parent shall notify the school within 30 days of the citizenship or immigration classification of the child under federal law.

Each school shall submit a report to the State Department of Education annually, of the data collected. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall report annually to the State Board of Education how enrollment of students not lawfully in the United States may affect the education of students who are citizens of Oklahoma.

The committee substitute to House Bill 3384 creates the “Oklahoma Illegal Immigration Review Act of 2010”. The measure requires all elementary and secondary schools to determine which students were born outside the jurisdiction of the United States and if they qualify for an English as a Second Language remedial program. Each school is required to submit an annual report to the State Department of Education. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction will report annually to the State Board of Education concerning students not lawfully in the United States and how their enrollment may affect the education of students who are legal citizens of Oklahoma.
