The Committee Substitute for SB 257 permits boards of technology center school districts to convey surplus property without consideration to other technology center school districts or to the Department of Career and Technology Education, whereas previously, they could only convey property to common school districts within tech center boundaries.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Provisions of the measure do not impact the state. Enabling equipment transfer among tech centers may reduce the need for some centers to purchase additional equipment.
