The measure allows a board of education of a technology center school district to convey surplus personal property without consideration to a technology center school district or to the Department of Career and Technology Education for the delivery of department initiatives.

# **Fiscal Summary**

ESB 257 permits boards of technology center school districts to convey surplus property without consideration to other technology center school districts or to the Department of Career and Technology Education, whereas previously, they could only convey property to common school districts within tech center boundaries.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

Provisions of the measure do not impact the state. Enabling equipment transfer among tech centers may reduce the need for some centers to purchase additional equipment.
