General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 5. Directs all state agencies to provide to the Chief Information Officer (CIO) a list of information technology assets that are integral to agency-specific applications or functions. Provides that information technology assets of appropriated agencies that are not integral to agency-specific functions will be transferred to the Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance (OSF) effective January 1, 2012. Information technology positions that are not integral to agency-specific functions will be transferred to OSF effective February 1, 2012.

Section 7. Allows a state agency to apply to the CIO for an exemption from the provisions of the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act or for an extension of any deadline under certain circumstances.

Section 9. Requires the CIO to submit quarterly progress reports, including the net savings realized through the consolidation of resources and personnel, to the Director of OSF and to the Legislature.
