PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public lands; amending 64 O.S. 2011, Section 1011, which relates to a revolving fund for the Commissioners of the Land Office; designating name of the fund; adding source of monies for the revolving fund; adding an expenditure purpose for the revolving fund; providing for investment of monies in the fund; requiring interest to be credited to the fund; amending 64 O.S. 2011, Section 1069, which relates to proceeds from bonuses, royalties and other inducements; creating the Multiyear Education Distribution Stabilization Revolving Fund; providing for deposit of bonuses and delay rental income; making the fund a continuing fund; making deposit of income contingent upon certain determination by the Commission; providing for investment of monies in the fund; requiring interest to be credited to the fund; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 64 O.S. 2011, Section 1011, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1011. A. There is hereby created a revolving fund ~~which~~ for the Commissioners of the Land Office to be designated the "Commissioners of the Land Office Revolving Fund". The fund shall

1 be a continuing fund not subject to fiscal year limitations,~~for the~~  
2 ~~Commissioners of the Land Office,~~ and into which shall be paid all  
3 fees that may be collected by the Commissioners of the Land Office  
4 and any appropriated monies designated for transfer into the fund.  
5 Monies from the fund may be used to pay for all books, forms, and  
6 other necessary equipment and supplies for the installation and  
7 maintenance of a modern system of accounting, necessary printing  
8 expenses, abstracts, refunds, expenses incidental to the operation  
9 of the Land Office, necessary communication and traveling expenses  
10 incurred by the employees of the Land Office, attorney fees and  
11 litigation expenses ~~and,~~ collection costs and expenses and  
12 conservation and commercial property upgrades. The Commissioners of  
13 the Land Office may also use monies in the revolving fund for any  
14 expenses of the Land Office related to personal services, operating  
15 expenses and the purchase of equipment necessary to carry out the  
16 function of the Land Office. All funds accruing to the fund are  
17 hereby appropriated. Monies in the fund may be invested by the  
18 State Treasurer in the manner prescribed in Section 89.1a et seq. of  
19 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Interest income derived from the  
20 investment of monies in the fund shall be credited to and placed in  
21 the fund.

22 B. There is hereby created a cash drawer change fund for the  
23 Commissioners of the Land Office. The fund shall be used as cash  
24 for the Land Office to make change for customers. The amount held

1 in the fund shall not exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). The  
2 initial amount in the fund shall be drawn by warrant from the  
3 revolving fund created pursuant to subsection A of this section.  
4 All adjustments to the amount retained in the fund shall be by  
5 withdrawal and deposit in the revolving fund established pursuant to  
6 subsection A of this section. No purchases shall be made from the  
7 fund. Officers, employees or agents of the Land Office shall be  
8 prohibited from receiving change from the fund. The Director of  
9 Accounting for the Land Office, with the approval of the internal  
10 auditor, shall prescribe forms, systems and procedures for the  
11 administration of the fund.

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 64 O.S. 2011, Section 1069, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1069. A. The proceeds derived in bonuses and royalties  
15 and from other inducements and considerations for the execution and  
16 operation of the oil and gas leases as authorized in this title,  
17 except oil and gas leases on state-owned lands set apart and  
18 designated for the use, benefit, and occupancy of state educational  
19 institutions, shall be for the use and benefit of the lands which  
20 were granted by the United States to the State of Oklahoma, and to  
21 the territory now comprising the area embraced within the state,  
22 under the provisions of the Enabling Act and any and all other Acts  
23 of Congress. Bonus and delay rental income received by the Land  
24 Office shall be distributed to current beneficiaries in like manner

1 as lease income received from surface leases, except that if  
2 determined to be in the best interest of the trust, the  
3 distributions may be made upon a schedule determined by a five-year  
4 rolling average of bonus and delay rental income.

5 B. There is hereby created a revolving fund for the  
6 Commissioners of the Land Office to be designated the "Multiyear  
7 Education Distribution Stabilization Revolving Fund". The fund  
8 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,  
9 and shall consist of bonus and delay rental income received by the  
10 Commission, if it is determined by the Commission to be in the best  
11 interest of the trust to make distributions of the income upon a  
12 five-year rolling average schedule as authorized in subsection A of  
13 this section. Monies in the fund may be invested by the State  
14 Treasurer in the manner prescribed in Section 89.1a et seq. of Title  
15 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Interest income derived from the  
16 investment of monies in the fund shall be credited to and placed in  
17 the fund.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

19 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
