Amendments:

1. Page 12, lines 5-15, by deleting all new language.
2. Page 30, line 12 by deleting after the semi-colon (;) all language.
3. Page 30, line 22, by deleting after the word "commission" the period (.) inserting a semi-colon (;) and the word "or".
4. Page 30, line 22 1/2 by inserting a new paragraph 27 to read as follows:

"27. The release of information to vendors that contract with the State of Oklahoma for the purpose of providing a public electronic labor exchange system that will support the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission's operation of an employment service system to connect employers with job seekers and military veterans. This labor exchange system would enhance the stability and security of Oklahoma's economy as well as support the provision of veterans' priority of service. The vendors may perform computer programming operations, perform computer maintenance or replacement operations, or host the electronic solution; provided each vendor agrees to protect and safeguard all information received, that no information shall be disclosed to any third party, that the use of the information shall be restricted to the scope of the contract, and

that the vendor shall properly dispose of all information when no longer needed for the purposes set out in the contract.”
