7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
9 to refer to the people for their approval or
10 rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma
11 Constitution by adding a new Section 36 to Article
12 II; prohibiting certain preferential treatment or
discrimination; stating applicability of act;
construing provisions; defining term; providing
remedies; providing ballot title; and directing
filing.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
16 1ST SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19 the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
20 adding a new Section 36 to Article II to read as follows:

21 Section 36. A. The state shall not grant preferential
22 treatment to, or discriminate against, any individual or group on
23 the basis of race, color, sex, ethnicity or national origin in the

1 operation of public employment, public education or public
2 contracting.

3 B. This section shall apply only to action taken after the
4 effective date of this section.

5 C. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted as prohibiting
6 bona fide qualifications based on sex that are reasonably necessary
7 to the normal operation of public employment, public education or
8 public contracting.

9 D. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted as invalidating
10 any court order or consent decree that is in force as of the
11 effective date of this section.

12 E. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted as prohibiting
13 action that must be taken to establish or maintain eligibility for
14 any federal program, where ineligibility would result in a loss of
15 federal funds to the state.

16 F. For the purposes of this section, "state" shall include, but
17 not be limited to, the state itself or an agency, institution,
18 instrumentality, or political subdivision of the state.

19 G. The remedies available for violations of this section shall
20 be the same, regardless of the injured party's race, color, sex,
21 ethnicity or national origin, as are otherwise available for
22 violations of the antidiscrimination laws of this state.

1 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3 the following form:

5 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

6 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

7 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It adds a new
8 Section 36 to Article II. It will not allow special treatment
9 or discrimination based on race or sex in public employment,
10 education or contracts. It gives exceptions for some
11 situations. It sets out remedies for violations.

15 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
16 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
