“SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 568 of Title 57, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created The Legislative Task Force to Study A Certificate of Relief from Disabilities, the purpose of which shall be to study the development within the Department of Corrections and the Pardon and Parole Board of a certificate program for persons who have been released or who are set for release from the custody of the Department of Corrections. The goal of such certificate program shall be to relieve an eligible person of any forfeiture or disability, or to remove any bar to employment automatically imposed by law by reason of a conviction of a crime or an offense; provided, however, such certificate shall not apply, or be construed so as to apply, to the right of such person to retain or to be eligible for public office.

B. The Task Force shall be composed of ten (10) legislators, five (5) appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, consisting of three (3) members from the majority party and two (2) members of the minority party; and five (5) appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, consisting of three (3) members from the majority party and two (2) members of the minority party. The Speaker shall appoint the chair of the Task Force and the President Pro Tempore shall appoint the vice chair. A quorum of the members present at a meeting of the Task Force shall be sufficient to conduct any business or take any action authorized or required. Travel reimbursement for the legislative members shall be made pursuant to Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

C. The Task Force shall convene not later than October 1, 2011, and shall issue a report of its findings and recommendations not later than January 31, 2012, at which time the Task Force shall cease to exist.
