An Act relating to highway and bridge designations; designating the SSGT Chaz Allen Highway; designating the Spec 4 Randy Derrick Memorial Bridge; designating the SPC Jordan M. Morris Memorial Highway; designating the SPC Joshua D. Sheppard-Young Memorial Highway; designating the 1LT David Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway; providing for placement of suitable permanent markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of State Highway 22 from the junction of State Highway 22 and State Highway 1 extending east to the intersection of State Highway 22 and northbound U.S. Highway 377 shall be designated as the SSGT Chaz Allen Highway. Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall

1 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
2 bearing that name.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge crossing Coal Creek on State Highway 3 in Coal County
7 shall be designated as the "Spec 4 Randy Derrick Memorial Bridge".
8 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

11 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of State Highway 108 from the junction of State
15 Highway 108 and State Highway 51 extending to the junction of State
16 Highway 108 and State Highway 33 shall be designated as the "SPC
17 Jordan M. Morris Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
18 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
19 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
20 bearing that name.

21 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 The portion of State Highway 71 from the intersection of State
2 Highway 71 and State Highway 9 extending approximately nine (9)
3 miles to the intersection of State Highway 71 and State Highway 31
4 shall be designated as the "SPC Joshua D. Sheppard-Young Memorial
5 Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma
6 Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The two-mile section of State Highway 37 in Moore, Oklahoma from
12 the junction of State Highway 37 and Eastern Avenue extending east
13 to the junction of State Highway 37 and Sunnyslane Road shall be
14 designated as the "1LT David Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway".
15 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
16 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
17 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

18 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
