7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Energy Independence
8 Act; amending Section 5, Chapter 122, O.S.L. 2009 (19
9 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 460.5), which relates to
loan requirements; clarifying loan repayment terms;
modifying certain lien placement and enforcement
provisions; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 122, O.S.L.

13 2009 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 460.5), is amended to read as
14 follows:

15 Section 450.5 A. The Oklahoma Energy Independence Act shall
16 apply to developed property on which property taxes are paid and on
17 which the owners of the property are current in the payment of the
18 property taxes.

19 B. ~~Unless other repayment arrangements are agreed to, the~~ The
20 ~~repayment of any loan made pursuant to the Oklahoma Energy~~
21 ~~Independence Act shall be in the same manner and at the same time as~~
22 ~~property taxes are paid upon such terms as may be agreed to by the~~
23 ~~property owner and the County Energy District Authority.~~

1 C. Any loan made pursuant to the Oklahoma Energy Independence
2 Act shall constitute a lien on the property which is the subject of
3 the loan only upon the recording of a mortgage covering the property
4 in the office of the county clerk. Any mortgage securing a loan
5 shall be junior and inferior to all previously recorded liens or
6 mortgages of any kind. The exclusive method of enforcing a lien for
7 failure to repay any loan made pursuant to the Oklahoma Energy
8 Independence Act shall be by judicial or nonjudicial foreclosure as
9 provided by law.

10 D. Only appliances or improvements that are permanently affixed
11 to the property shall be eligible for financing pursuant to the
12 Oklahoma Energy Independence Act.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.

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
