	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
22	SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation is hereby						
23	authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012,						
24	from the State Transportation Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of						

1	Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
2	to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Transportation
3	by law. Said authorization shall be transferred to the State
4	Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund and shall be expended in
5	the same manner and for the same purposes as provided by law for
6	other monies accruing to the credit of the State Highway
7	Construction and Maintenance Fund.
8	SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
9	Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
10	State Transportation Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
11	ending June 30, 2012, the sum of Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
12	thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
13	Department of Transportation by law. Said appropriation shall be
14	transferred to the State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund
15	and shall be expended for the purpose set forth in Section 2002 of

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SECTION 7. All funds available by law for expenditure by the Department of Transportation may be used and expended in conjunction or cooperation with any federal agency or instrumentality pursuant to such terms and conditions as may be necessary to obtain grants or federal aid assistance in accordance with state law.

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SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 (hereafter FY-13). Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2012, and must be expended by November 15, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, and not budgeted for FY-13, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-13 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2013. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2013, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-12, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-13, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-12 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.
