AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to congressional and legislative districts; creating the Oklahoma Congressional Redistricting Act of 2011; repealing 14 O.S. 2001, Sections 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.5, which relate to the Oklahoma Congressional Redistricting Act of 1991; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6.1 of Title 14, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Congressional Redistricting Act of 2011".

SECTION 2. REPEALER 14 O.S. 2001, Sections 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.5, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
