18	the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article XXV of the

20	Section 25. The Department of Public Welfare <u>Human Services</u>
21	shall be under the control of a commission to be known as the
22	Oklahoma Public Welfare <u>Human Services</u> Commission, composed of nine
23	members appointed by the Governor and selected on the basis of
24	recognized interest in and knowledge of the problems of public

welfare. Each member of the Commission shall be at least thirty years of age, shall be a citizen of the United States, and shall have been a qualified elector of Oklahoma at least five years next preceding his or her appointment. Members of the Commission or any person employed by and working under direction of said the Commission may be of either sex. Immediately upon the taking effect of this Article, the Governor shall appoint the members of said the Commission for terms of office as follows: One member for a term of one year, one member for a term of two years, one member for a term of three years, one member for a term of four years, one member for a term of five years, one member for a term of six years, one member for a term of seven years, one member for a term of eight years and one member for a term of nine years. Except as above designated, the term of office of the members of said the Commission shall be nine years or until their successors are appointed and qualified. The Governor shall designate one member of the Commission as chairman chair. Members of the Commission shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be allowed necessary traveling and other expenses actually incurred while in the performance of their official duties. The Governor shall have the power to fill vacancies on the Commission for the remainder of the unexpired term.
